

GRADE INFORMATION

All Graded work is given a point value:

Tests are worth 100 points Quizzes are worth 20 or 50 points
Graded Labs are worth 25 points Homework assignments are worth 5 or 10 points

Work will be given a grade showing how many points you earned, for example:

On a test you may get a grade of 87 / 100, meaning you earned 87 points out of the total of 100 possible points.

On a lab you may get a grade of 23 / 25, meaning you earned 23 points out of the total possible.

On a quiz you may get a 20 / 20, meaning you earned the total number of points possible.

Calculating your own grade: (You must keep track of all of your grades.)

- #1 Add up the total number of points that you **earned** during a marking period.
- #2 Add up the total number of points that you **could have** earned. (possible points)
- #3 Take the value of (#1 ÷ #2) and multiply by 100.

[In the example above, #1 = 87 + 23 + 20 = 130
 #2 = 100 + 25 + 20 = 145
 #3 = (130 ÷ 145) x 100 = **89.7 %** The final grade is a **90**]

Extra Credit:

Any extra credit points that you earn are added to the value of #1.

[In the example above, if the student earned 3 bonus points:

#1 = 133 #2 = 145 #3 = **92**]
