

RULES & GUIDELINES

- 1 The only way to learn is to be in class. This means both physically and mentally. (Make sure that you understand the school's attendance policy.)
- 2 Respect your classmates, your teacher and yourself. This means don't be disruptive or talk without permission. You are expected to be in your seat at all times during class.
- 3 Turn in all assignments on the day they are due. Homework is a large portion of your grade -- if it is late you will be penalized significantly.
- 4 During laboratory activities, pay close attention to the teacher's instructions, and only perform approved experiments. This is for the safety of everyone.
- 5 If you have any questions or concerns about the class or subject matter, please speak to the teacher. After school review sessions are encouraged.
- 6 **It is your responsibility to get notes and assignments when you have been absent.** Any student absent on a test day is expected to make up the test on the day that they return to school.
- 7 Follow all school rules and regulations, knowing the consequences of failing to do so. (I strongly urge you to read the Student Handbook). Minor discipline problems will be punished with science lab detention. Major problems will be referred to the school administrators.
