ACCOUNTABLE

Balanced people have the ability to learn from experiences and adjust their priorities to ensure that they are healthy physically, mentally, and emotionally.

Collaborative people surround themselves with a team because they know that a group is stronger than any one individual.

INDEPENDENT

Independent people are confident in their skills and unafraid to fail, yet seek out help when they recognize support is needed.

Curious people ask questions, innovate, and are eager to learn because they are filled with wonder and have an enthusiasm for learning.
