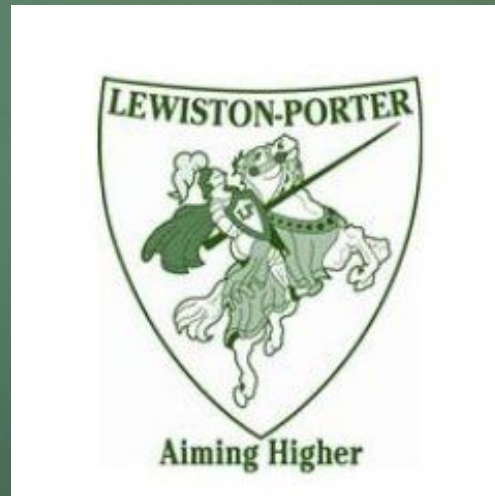

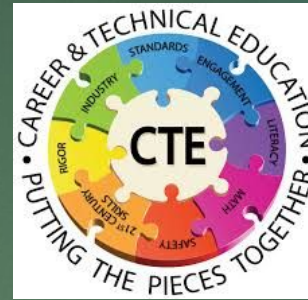
Course Selection Process


