Senior Awards Night

When: Thursday, June 6, 2024 @ 6:00 PM

Where: Lew-Port High School Auditorium

What: Students that have won an award, honor, or scholarship from the senior class will be invited to attend, along with their parents and families.



Class Day

When: Thursday, June 13, 2023 @ 8:00 AM - 2:40 PM

Where: Lew-Port campus, around town (parade), Kiwanis Park (picnic)

What:

- Breakfast at the high school in the cafeteria
- Senior Awards, Thank-yous, Class of 2024 slideshow students only (auditorium)
- In the cafeteria: Hand in your chromebook, then receive cap and gown, pick up your ordered yearbook
- Take the "Senior Walk" through the PEC, IEC, Middle School and High School
- Line up for car parade, led by Lewiston Police
- Parade through Youngstown, up River Road, and into Lewiston, ending at Kiwanis Park
- Lunch provided by Lewiston Police
- Students can stay and play yard games and are dismissed following lunch from Kiwanis park

Senior Prom 2024

When: Friday, June 14, 2024 @ 6:00 PM - 10:00 PM

Where: Doubletree by Hilton, 401 Buffalo Ave, Niagara Falls, NY 14303

What: A buffet style dinner with music, desserts, photo booth, and other entertainment provided in your ticket cost

Cost: \$55 each. Tickets are nonrefundable and will **be on sale May 20 - May 31 ONLY**. Only Lew-Port seniors are permitted to purchase a ticket.

Guests: Seniors may bring 1 guest. Guests that do not attend Lew-Port must have a *Guest Authorization Form* filled out when purchasing a ticket. These are available from Mrs. D'Anna and Dr. Moskaluk, and are also on Google Classroom. If the guest does not attend our school, they must submit a copy of their photo ID before a ticket is purchased for them. Guests must be under the age of 21.

Dress code: Formal attire

Searches and screenings: Regular search procedures will be in place and students found to have vape devices, drugs, alcohol, or paraphernalia will be subject to removal from Prom, without refund, and will be subject to disciplinary action that could impact their ability to participate in graduation.

Graduation Rehearsal - Mandatory

When: Tuesday, June 25, 2024 @ 1:00 PM

Where: Artpark, 450 S. Fourth Street, Lewiston, NY

Directions: Park in the parking lot at the end of Fourth Street, enter the gates and be given directions for which terrace to go to at the top of the amphitheater.

- Rehearsal will last approximately 1 to 1.5 hours (plan accordingly now with employer).
- Any student that did not attend Class Day will receive a cap and gown at rehearsal.
- Honors tassels will be given out at rehearsal.
- Mr. D'Anna and advisors will go over any last minute graduation directions.
- Tickets for graduation will be given out (each graduate gets 6 guest tickets and 1 graduate ticket). If a graduate needs more tickets they will receive a request form in Participation and Government and Economics class after Memorial Day.
- We will practice the ceremony, so it is imperative that you be present to know where you are lining up, sitting, etc.

Graduation

When: Wednesday, June 26, 2024 @ 7:00 PM

*****Graduates should arrive at 6:15 PM!*****

Where: Artpark, 450 S. Fourth Street, Lewiston, NY

Directions: Every person, *including graduates*, needs to have a ticket to enter Artpark. Seating is general admission.

Dress code:

- Students must wear: cap, gown and tassel to walk the stage.
- It is recommended that you hang your gown after Class Day to help smooth out wrinkles. *DO NOT IRON!* The gown will melt and we do not have extras.
- The tassel starts on the right side of your cap (we will move them to the left together during the ceremony).
- **DO NOT WEAR jeans, shorts, sneakers, or flip flops.** If you wear heels, we recommend that they are short to avoid tripping on the stairs/stage.
- Do not bring a bag or purse - there is no place to store it and you can't carry it while walking. Leave personal belongings with your family or at home.
- If you have not ordered a cap and gown, you need to contact Tom McGrath at Jostens (716-688-4077) and do so immediately- the school does not provide them.

Important Notes:

- Students are expected to demonstrate responsible and mature behavior before and during the ceremony.
- Students may NOT decorate caps and gowns - they will be inspected prior to the ceremony by chaperones and you will not be allowed to walk if you have changed the look in any way.
- Caps are sometimes difficult to keep on a student's head- it is recommended to use bobby pins to keep it from slipping.
- Parents are welcome to take photos, and there will also be a professional photographer present to take photos of students receiving their diploma. These pictures will be available to order.
