Program Enhancement Teacher Mini Grant Program

The goal of the Lewiston-Porter Mini Grant is to fund an activity or learning experience for students that would not be available through regular budget allocations. We realize that teachers often spend their own money for materials or items that enhance learning and instruction. The Alumni Association hopes to offset some of these expenditures through the mini grant process. Grant applications will be available through email and the website on September 24, 2018 and must be returned by October 18, 2018 to your building's main office. Awards will be made by mid-November after a subcommittee of the Alumni Association reviews the grant requests.

Potential uses for the money would be for teaching materials, guest speakers, field trip expenses, a piece of non-standard equipment, such as software, math manipulatives or electronics. It is anticipated that the grants would encourage teacher creativity and enhance student learning.

An evaluation/follow-up is to be submitted to the Association next May and will take the form of a narrative, photo essay or an oral presentation.

The maximum award is \$500.00. Applications should be returned to your building's main office on **October 18, 2018**, and must be signed by your building principal.
