- Students will follow the Day 1-6 schedule for their special (i.e., Art, Library, Music, Physical Education, and/or Technology). Students will receive asynchronous assignments from their special area teachers to complete during the asynchronous student work time. Any student who would like to have synchronous conferencing with a special area teacher may do so by reaching out to schedule an appointment.
- Class attendance will include synchronous instruction but may also include asynchronous learning opportunities for students.
- Students are expected to participate in their synchronous learning and complete their assignments to obtain credit for attendance for any particular class period.
