

Approval for the Issuance of a Request for Proposals for the Fianancing of the Equipment - Energy Performance Project	AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS ("RFP") FOR THE FINANCING OF THE EQUIPMENT INVOLVED IN AN ENERGY PERFORMANCE PROJECT TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY THE DISTRICT WHEREAS, Article 9 of the New York Energy Law authorizes the Lewiston-Porter Central School District, Niagara County, New York (the "District") to enter into an energy performance contract for the planning and implementation of energy conservation and efficiency improvements involving the installation of solar panels on the rooftops at the Primary Education Center and the Senior High School (the "Contract"); and WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 9, the cost of any such energy conservation improvements will be funded entirely through the cost reductions to be obtained by such improvements, and voter authorization is not required; and WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the District (the "Board") has approved the selection of an energy performance contractor, TM Montante Solar Developments LLC ("TM Montante") which has conducted a comprehensive energy audit; and WHEREAS, the District now wishes to issue and advertise a written request for proposals ("RFP") for the financing of the equipment to be installed and the improvements to be made under the Contract; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby authorizes the issuance of an RFP for the provision of the necessary financing of such equipment and improvements contemplated under the Contract; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the RFP will be in a form satisfactory to the District's Superintendent of Schools (acting in consultation with the District's municipal advisor and counsel); and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board hereby directs and authorizes the District's Superintendent of Schools to undertake all steps reasonably necessary and appropriate to issue and advertise such RFP; and	NA-5
