Resolution to Approve the Settlement Agreement with the Town of Porter and CWM Chemical Services, LLC	<ul> <li>WHEREAS, the Lewiston-Porter Central School District (the "District") has been involved in tax assessment challenge litigation brought by CWM Chemical Services, LLC which sought to reduce their tax obligation on various properties for the past several years and continuing into future years ("Litigation"); and</li> <li>WHEREAS, the District has been working cooperatively with the County of Niagara and the Town of Porter in defending the Litigation, which is scheduled for trial in June, 2023; and</li> <li>WHEREAS, the parties to the Litigation recently entered mediation in an attempt to resolve the matter without conducting a trial, where a settlement proposal has been negotiated that has been recommended by District Counsel and explained to the Board; and NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:</li> <li>1. That the Board of Education hereby approves the terms of a Settlement Agreement as presented to the Board, and authorizes the Superintendent and/or District Counsel to execute the Settlement Agreement and other necessary documents by and between the Lewiston-Porter Central School District, County of Niagara, Town of Porter and CWM Chemical Services, LLC, which settles the tax certiorari litigation between the parties.</li> <li>The following vote was taken and recorded in the public or open of said meeting.</li> </ul>	NA-1 Approved, CARRIED, 6-0
