Job description:

Advisors are expected to set a club schedule and actively communicate with students, parents and their principal; keep records of meetings and student participation (including sign-in sheets); and provide a Club/Activity Advisor Report annually to the LPUT Club Committee.

Advisors of clubs/activities that are approved by the Board of Education to utilize an Extraclassroom Activity Fund will be required to complete annual training (timing of which is to be determined). Clubs/activities are approved for Extraclassroom Activity Funds at the annual Organizational meeting in July, per federal guidelines.

*Denotes those club/activities that are currently approved for an Extraclassroom Activity Fund. Please note: Additional clubs/activities may be approved.

Points of Clarification:

Each co-curricular or extracurricular position is an annual appointment. Please be advised that staff members do not have an inherent right to continue in any position because they may currently hold a co-curricular or extracurricular position.

Multiple applicants for the same position will be interviewed before final determination has been made in recommending a candidate to the Board of Education for appointment per the LPUT Collective Bargaining Agreement.

All co- and extracurricular positions will be posted initially for ten (10) days. At the close of the initial posting, any unfilled positions will be posted a second and final time for five (5) days. Any club/activity that is unfilled at the close of the second and final posting will be replaced with an activity as determined by the LPUT Co- and Extracurricular Committee.
