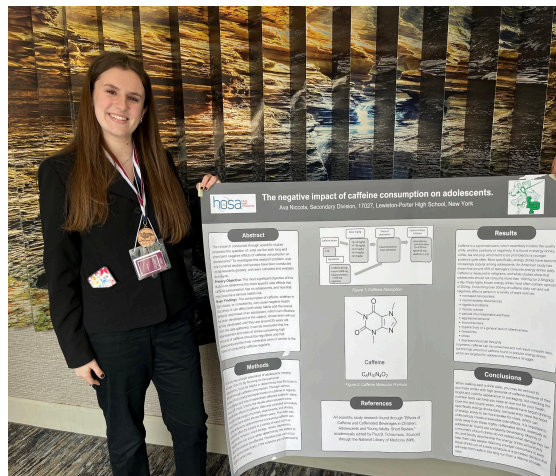
Our Ava Niccola won 3rd place in the state for her research poster and speech. This qualifies her for the international leadership conference in Houston at the end of June!
