## General

- Off to a good start! As you are aware, and similar to last year, we used the first day as a CREW day for students. The CREW Crew consisting of Kevin Kirsch, Kim Alexander, Nina Calarco, Joe Conti, Stephanie Bond and Claire Marshall planned throughout the summer to plan for a first day of activities for our students. The <u>First Day Schedule</u> included a scavenger hunt, team flag creation, a community gathering and team building activities all designed to help students feel more comfortable with the start of a new school year and to acclimate them to their fellow students and teachers in the middle school. All of this to continue to establish a positive culture of our building.
