#### Middle State Objectives and Actions:

#### Action Plan 1:

Improve Graduation Rate: By 2032, the graduation rate as articulated in the NYSSED School report card will increase approximately 1.0 percent per year for a total of approximately 7.0 percent over a 7-year period.

#### Action Plan 2:

By 2032, Lew-Port High School will have an efficient plan to identify training needs and provide PD experiences so that all eligible faculty and staff are up-to-date and automatically reminded, enrolled in and successfully complete all Mandated Trainings including CPR, AED, NARCAN Nasal Spray, SEL/Social Emotional/Mental Health, and Restorative Practice.

#### Action Plan 3:

To increase Regent Exam scores by 2% each year for the next 5 years in Living Environment, Earth Science, Chemistry, and Geometry, it is essential for students to take ownership of their learning and actively engage in strategies that promote self-directed improvement by tracking quarterly progress, reviewing past exams, practicing sample Regents, and attend after school tutoring.

#### Action Plan 4:

By 2032, reduce chronic absenteeism in high school by 3% annually, achieving a total reduction of 21% over the next 7 years, through targeted interventions, increased student engagement, and stronger partnerships with families and the community.
