Items of Note

- Quarter 3 (30 Weeks): ends Friday, March 28
 - We continue to identify students that MUST attend the After School Assistance Program (ASAP), for students failing one or more subjects. The goal is to have students stay after school from 2:45 - 3:40 to make up any missing work or work with a teacher to get the failing grade up to pass before the close of the marking period.
 - Jeopardy of Failing letters are being sent out by our Guidance office and subsequent parent conferences are being scheduled as necessary.

Reminder:

- Students in exploratory classes in 6th grade are now based upon trimesters rather than quarters, particularly Art,
 Music, and Business Technology. This adjustment was made because 6th grade students do not take Health and
 so it was removed from the exploratory rotation.
- This exploratory schedule ONLY affects students in 6th grade who will rotate to one of the three exploratory classes Art, Music, and Business Technology in the following manner:

 - Trimester 3- 3/11-6/16 (59 days)- 3 extra days in trimester 3 to accommodate for the most testing/ shortened periods (State testing and AIMS WEB)
- 7th grade and 8th grade students will continue to follow a quarterly rotation for exploratory classes based on the following:
 - Quarter 1 Ends 11/1 (42 days)
 - o Quarter 2 Ends 1/24/25 (41 days)
 - Quarter 3 Ends 3/28/25 (42 days)
 - Quarter 4 Ends 6/27/25 (42 days Assuming classes end on 6/13. 52 days if potential Final exam days are included)
- Winter Dance The Student Council hosted a Starry Night Dance on March 7th from 6pm 8pm for all Lewiston Porter Middle School students who purchased a \$10 ticket. We had over 225 students attend and all seemed to have a great time with their friends!

- Our 8th Grade student WEB Leaders presented to our faculty and staff asking them to consider 7th grade students for
