This scholarship is being provided in memory of Chuck Pollock. Chuck was a three-year football letterman and an instrumental part of the 1970 & 1971 Lancer football team that went 16-0. He served as a captain his senior year. He was also a two-year baseball letterman and is a member of the Lewiston Porter Athletic Hall of Fame. Chuck played football at Marshall University. A devoted husband and father, Chuck had a successful business career and was a talented musician among his other accomplishments.
