- Open to all senior class students
- Must possess the following qualities:
- Dependability (which includes truthfulness, loyalty, punctuality, and being worthy of trust)
- Service (which includes cooperation, courtesy, and contributing to the welfare of others)
- Leadership (which includes personality, self-control, and ability to assume responsibility, ability to inspire others, and a decision-maker)
- Patriotism (which includes devotion to and support of one's country, supporting service members and veterans, working for causes that make one's community stronger, and appreciating the cultural and historic importance of America's unique population)

### Follow Part I & Part II instructions to complete:

\*Complete the following in outline format: A. List high school activities, including offices held, awards received, athletic, music,etc. B. describe briefly how your efforts to serve your community have been effective or have made a difference, C. express your future plans, education and career goals, and aspirations in life, D. list extracurricular activities, scouting, after-school or summer jobs, hobbies, etc. E. describe briefly why you feel the four qualities of a DAR Good Citizen are important and how you have tried to exhibit those qualities in your life and in relationship with others. Include 2 Letters of Recommendation and Guidance will attach a transcript.

Part III is a timed essay to be administered under supervision of faculty and must be completed at one sitting, within a 2 hour time limit without assistance or reference materials. Each contest entry is evaluated by independent, non-DAR judges. The winning entry is advanced through state, divisional, and national levels of judging.
