Complete in order-3 year plan with confirmed funding souces...complete steps as to

- Hallway space for 2D and 3D works
- Section for alumni/visiting artist Show case
- Lew Port Perm art collection
- Rotating current student works (2D and 3D)
- Purchase and locate contemporary seating/couch/table locations
- Make this space a destination location for receptions/events/talks (as they are currently in the vestibule glass hallway)
- What is budget?????
- Brett-remove floating ceiling and expose the structural ceiling
- Paint walls FLAT gray continue the gray (match the marble in stairway) into the art studio wing for continuity of action
- Create standardized brushed dark green metal Nielson frame install/changeable system add cost frame, plexi, and foam core backing..AND HARDWARE????
- Lighting- raise the florescent lights, later replace with "LED green" lighting (rebate/bonus)
- Possible seating locations and/or relocate the event/mtg receptions (that now happen on first floor at glass entrance to 2nd floor art wing)...making it a destination location (no longer just a pass-through to get to north wing of school)for receptions/presentations
- Exhibition cases for perm display, budget?, from Hadley to Gaylord, uline to MDF wood pedestals (paint gray) with ¼ inch plexi-5sided boxes.

3 year plan - structured for conservative budget allocations for a three-year period

Year One

Paint Lewiston Porter Fine Arts Alumni & Student Exhibition Gallery hallway gray (to match color of marble in vestibule), paint first floor art dept. studio(s) hallway same color (continuity).

Purchase Nielson (deep reveal) brushed metal (dark green) frames, plexi, foamcore standard sizing (24 x36, 30x40, 36x48)

Remove floating ceiling (or can be Year Two) "finish" the walls (paint to interior roof/ceiling) raise the florescent lights and leave hardwire "as-is"

Build a contact list of Lew-Port "art dept." alumni for rotating exhibition (highlingts0 and also build into the visiting artist program- direct correlation and integrative learning opportunities AND local/regional business /internship opportunities?

Purchase and locate a number of seating areas coffee/or "bar top" tables

Year Two

Purchase exhibition cases for perm display, (pending budget allocations), from Hadley to Gaylord, uline – to MDF wood pedestals (paint gray) with ¼ inch plexi-5 sided boxes.

Secure a sponsor "naming" opportunity for the Lewiston Porter Fine Arts Alumni & Student Exhibition Gallery

Year Three

Dedicate the space to the sponsor and/or general dedication of the Lewiston Porter Fine Arts Alumni & Student Exhibition Gallery
