Science National Honor Society

Science national honor society is a national organization that recognizes students with a passion for scientific study. Student advisor Ms. Hinchliffe commented “We hold our induction ceremony in the fall, and students with a science average of 85 or higher on Regents exams and having enrolled in one AP science course are eligible for invitation to the society. As a group, we accomplish many goals. First, we participate in community service by supporting the Niagara County Science Fair held at Stella educational park. Our students develop stem-based activities to engage the K-8 science fair participants during the daylong event. In the past, we have worked with the Lewiston Library Science Explorers Club with their science activities for young readers. Secondly, we have done school related activities. Last year, students designed and painted science and math related hallway murals. This year, the group wished to host a STEM night with a district wide Stomp Rocket competition until Covid 19 disrupted our school year. Finally, the group organized a Science Olympiad team and competed regionally at Buffalo State. These young scientists did very well and qualified for the state competition. Unfortunately, this state competition was cancelled due to Covid 19.” She added “Personally, I enjoy working with these science-minded students. Every year is a new adventure and their passion for science keeps the experience engaging and reinvigorating for me as an educator.”
