Each year, the Teacher Center—a New York State grant-funded organization dedicated to providing high-quality professional learning—hosts a literacy contest for students in grades K–8. The various demonstrations aimed to remind the students about safe driving tips and behaviors ahead of prom.


Students first gathered outside where they witnessed a mock-car crash demonstration.



Many of the students winning medals have the opportunity to move on to the National competition in Atlanta, Georgia in June.








